


BUDGETING FOR YOUR NEW HOME

DESIGN PROCESS: FROM CONCEPT TO CONSTRUCTION

Red Barn leads the design process from high-level **Concept Design** through **Construction Documents**. We evaluate site circulation, weather patterns, and views to inform space adjacencies, developing floor plans and elevations. Once **Schematic Design** is complete, we engage contractors for a budget check.

During **Design Development**, we focus on integrating systems like HVAC and structural elements, while refining material selections. We will spend significant time learning how your household uses key spaces such as the kitchen, including any specialty appliance considerations, overall appliance package, storage needs and finally, cabinetry to house it all.

Care is taken to select plumbing and lighting fixtures that reflect your tastes and needs. Interior Design is an integral part of this process and is advanced alongside all of the other demands of the project. We use inhouse renderings and mood boards to help you visualize design choices.

Construction Documents turn design concepts into detailed technical plans that guide the entire build. Red Barn ensures seamless integration of structural, mechanical, and aesthetic elements by coordinating with engineers, contractors, and consultants. These precise documents minimize delays, reduce errors, and ensure every detail aligns with your vision, providing a smooth path from design to construction. Once the Construction Documents are finalized, the contractor applies for permits, marking the start of the building phase.
